As you may be aware, the Carillion situation has resulted in uncertainty for many employees, contractors and apprentices.

It is important to underline that Carillion has not announced any redundancies at this point but we are looking ahead at how we can help should redundancies need to be made.

We have been in contact with the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) to offer our support to those affected. DWP representatives have asked that Energy & Utility Skills coordinates our sector's response on behalf of our members to ensure best use of resources – a role we are happy to facilitate. As a result, the DWP has agreed to signpost those who have expressed an interest in our sector, to Talent Source Network, our online sector attraction platform that carries vacancies from 20 leading employers from the Energy & Utilities Skills Partnership.

This continues our ongoing work with the DWP, who partnered with us during Talent Source Network's pilot year to bring socially disadvantaged people into our workforce.

To ensure visibility of the opportunities available to those affected, the DWP have begun to reach out to employers seeking guidance on capacity to support.
