Apprenticeships, technical education and skills have been the subject of further scrutiny by Parliamentary select committees over recent weeks. The 'Education Committee' and the 'Economics Affairs Committee' reviewed evidence on apprenticeships and lifelong learning; funding; value for money; quality of apprenticeships and training provision from key stakeholders (academic experts, employer bodies, specialist groups on apprenticeships and technical education).

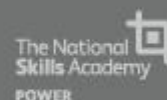
