

GAS NETWORKS DEMOGRAPHICS

The **UK gas networks sector** employs approximately



8% of the sector's workforce identify themselves as from Black, Asian or Minority Ethnic (BAME) backgrounds; ethnic diversity is greatest in the East Midlands at **27%** BAME, compared to 15% for all sectors.
