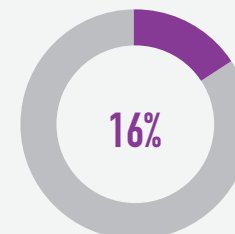

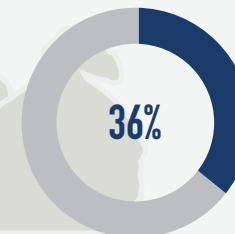

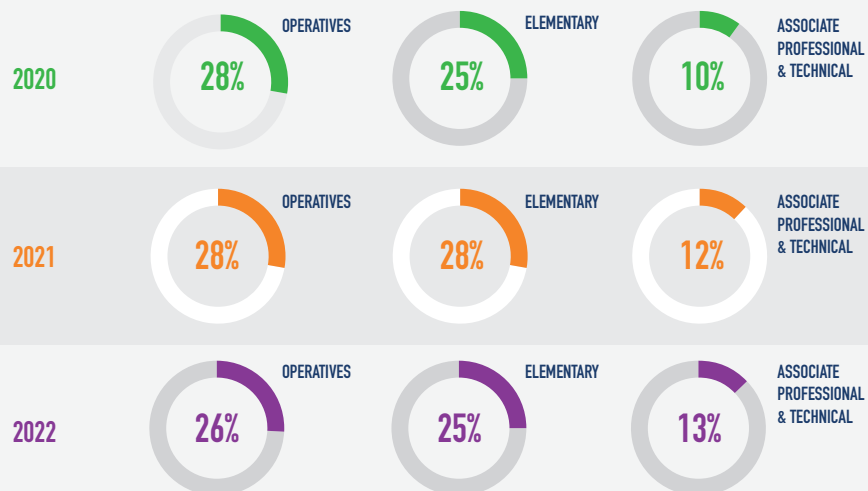

Energy & Utility Skills' estimate based on Labour Force Survey (ONS) 4-quarter average (January-December 2022)

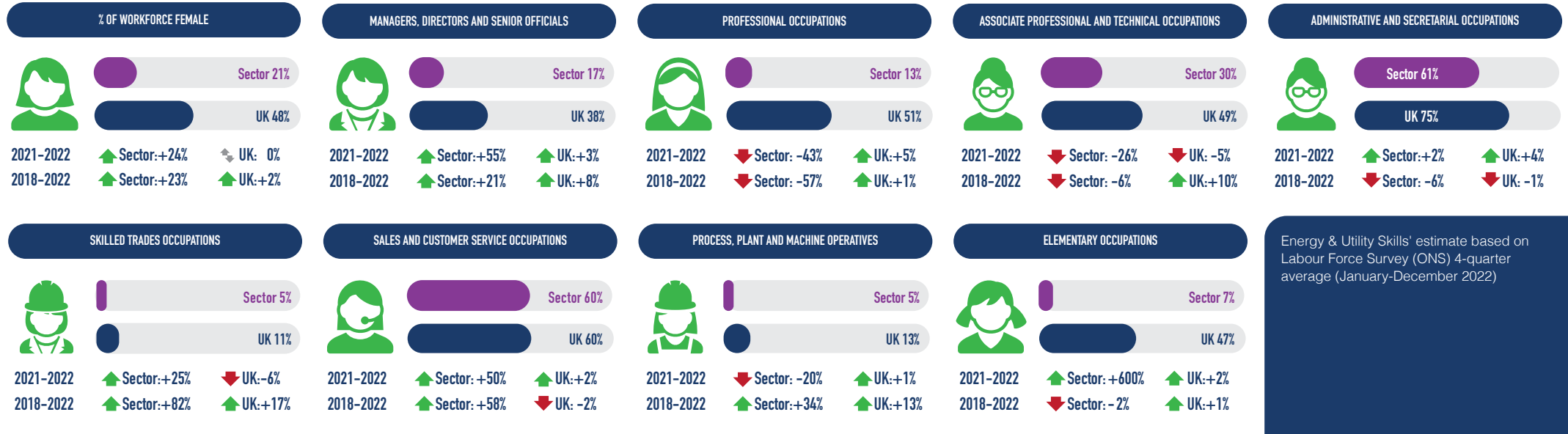
## FORECAST NUMBER OF NEW PEOPLE NEEDED IN THE WORKFORCE BY 2030\*

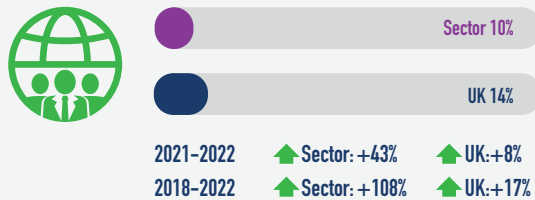

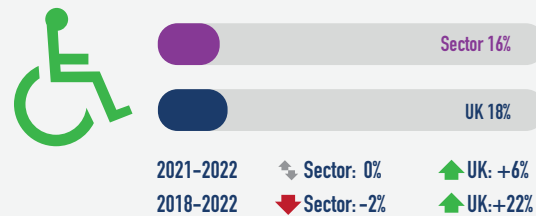
### PERCENTAGE OF WASTE INDUSTRY WORKFORCE - FEMALE



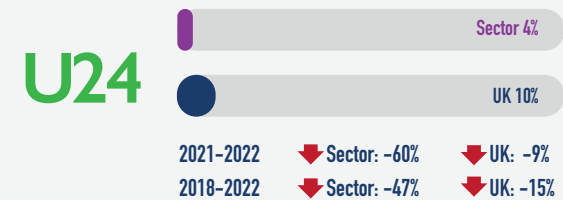
### PERCENTAGE OF WASTE INDUSTRY WORKFORCE - ETHNIC MINORITY



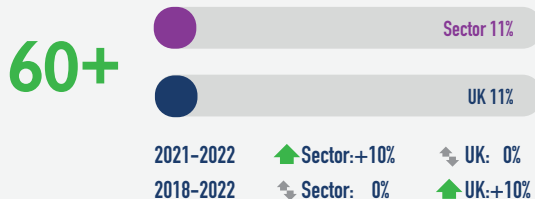
### PERCENTAGE OF WASTE INDUSTRY WORKFORCE - DISABLED
