Working in collaboration with a range of stakeholders including, certification bodies, awarding organisations, industry employers and Gas Safe Register, you will ensure that the Matters of Gas Safety criteria is produced in line with industry standards and technological developments.

Key Responsibilities:

The key responsibilities of the Gas Technical Manager include::

- Produce and maintain Matters of Gas Safety (MoGS) assessment criteria and training specifications, including the timely issue of these to awarding organisations and certification bodies.
- Work in collaboration with industry employers and key stakeholders, as part of our Technical Working Groups and Standard Consultation Forum, to review the MoGS assessment criteria in line with industry technical standards and legislation, ensuring compliance with the requirements of BSEN ISO 17024 Nationally Accredited Certification Scheme (ACS) and BSEN ISO 17021 the Group Competency Scheme (GCS).
- Analyse and evaluate the potential impact of new or proposed technical standards on the MoGS assessment criteria in order to produce documented options for industry consultation.



- Manage the processes and procedures required to support the Gas Industry Standard Setting Function in the update and implementation of MoGS criteria.
- Act as the key point of contact for all queries and complaints received in relation to MoGS assessments leading to Gas Safe Registration.
- Work with marketing to ensure all information published on our company website relating to the Gas Industry Standard Setting Body is accurate and kept up to date.

Additional responsibilities

- Ensure compliance with Energy & Utility Skills data protection policies and processes.
