

Online Job Postings – Waste & Recycling May 2025





This summary of online job postings in the UK waste management and recycling industry relates to the year ending 30th April 2025.

There were 5,908 job postings in the waste and recycling industry in the year ending 30th April 2025 – 14% lower than the 6,892 recorded in the previous year.


The estimated average duration that job postings were "live" was 21 days (down from 28 days in the previous year).

- Biffa and Suez were the largest recruiters in the waste and recycling industry over the past year
- ➤ The **region** with the highest number of job postings was the South East (959)
 - At a more local level, Bristol saw the highest number of job postings (212)
- The Job Title with the largest number of vacancies over the past year was HGV drivers (607)

- Waste management was the most soughtafter specialist skill (800)
- Customer Service skills were the most sought-after common skill (1,914)
- Microsoft Office skills were the most sought-after software skill (393)
 - Despite the fall in online job postings over the year, it is interesting to note that demand for Power BI skills actually increased – the only skill to increase in demand over the year
- ➤ The **Median** advertised salary was £32,700 in April 2025 up 7.6% over the year
- ➤ Of the vacancies detailed above, 104 were Apprenticeship vacancies – down from 111 in the previous year
 - The median advertised salary for an apprenticeship was £24,000 (up 13% over the year)

➤ In the year ending 30th April 2025, there were 5,908 online job postings – peaking in April 2025 at 1,217

- The **region** with the highest number of job postings was the South East (959)
- > Yorkshire and The Humber was the only region that saw an increase in job postings compared with the previous year (up 41% over the year)

- > The **Job Title** with the largest number of vacancies over the past year was HGV drivers (607)
- The job title which saw the highest growth in job postings over the previous year was Weighbridge Operators (up 22% over the year)


➤ Microsoft Office skills were the most sought-after **software skill** (393)


Salary

➤ The **Median** advertised salary was £32,700 in April 2025 – up 7.6% over the year



Apprenticeships

- ➤ Of the vacancies detailed above, 104 were Apprenticeship vacancies down from 111 in the previous year
 - > Apprenticeship job postings peaked in March 2025, with 32



- ➤ The largest recruiters of Apprenticeships over the past year were Biffa, Veolia and European Metal Recycling
- The median advertised salary for an apprenticeship was £24,000 (up 13% over the year)
